Miss Sarah—Pre K News

Welcome to September! It is a time for new beginnings, new experiences, and new challenges, as well as new friends, as we start our pre k readiness program.

This month, we will be focusing on back to school the first week. We will be learning basic skills such as cutting, color identification and shape and number identification. We will use the writing center to learn how to write our names. We will also be playing in the dramatic play area, exploring our Back to School theme. The children will explore all of our interest areas— math, science, social studies, dramatic play, art and technology as we dive into a back to school focus.

The second week in September, our theme will be "All About Me". We will learn about how we are all different, but all the same at the same time. In the math center, we will graph all of our different eye colors. In the science area, we will look at our fingerprints with a magnifying glass, along with a lot of other fun, "All About Me" activities.

The third week of September, we will focus on our author of the month, Laura Numeroff. She wrote a variety of fun books that involve different kinds of animals and activities that include a sequence of events that lead to some messy situations! Her book "If You Take a Mouse to School", will be the inspiration for us to use our scientific inquiry skills, and we'll be making a purple volcano! In our dramatic play area, the children will enjoy a party theme, using "If You Give a Pig a Party" as our example. Finally, we will have a yummy snack of doughnuts in honor of the book "If You Give a Dog a Donut". The last two weeks in September, we will be focusing on apples. We will explore the inside and outside of an apple, different colors of apples and different tastes of apples. We will employ our math skills to find out what shape is found in the middle of an apple, and we will count apple seeds. The children will learn how to make applesauce, along with a science lesson on the process of converting a solids into liquids. We will celebrate Johnny Appleseed's birthday with a yummy snack of apple smiles!

On September 11th, we will honor our grandparents during Goodies With Grandparents, which will run from 2:30pm to 3:30 pm.

On September 16th, the Pre-k class will be hosting our annual "MeetThe Teacher" night from 6pm -7pm . We encourage all of our families to come and visit our classroom to learn about all of the fun learning experiences that we offer to prepare your children for kindergarten.

On Friday, September 25th, the pre-k class will have picture day. More information will follow at a later date!

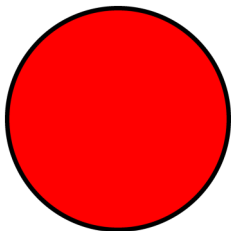
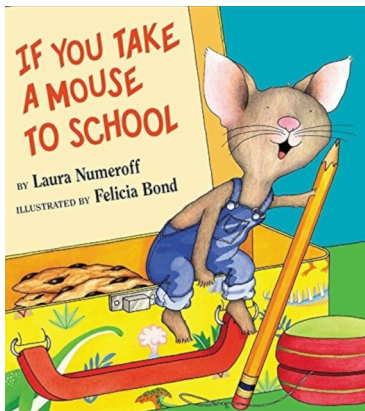
